Student IDs

Student IDs are required to be worn on a lanyard or badge clip at all times. Students arriving without their ID will be directed to the office.

Replacing lost or broken IDs is the responsibility of the student. Replacements can be purchased at the front office.

Attendance

Regular school attendance is vital for a child to be successful. A child who is not in school cannot learn. Absences totaling 18 days or more (including excused absences) is considered excessive and a child may be retained.

Students will be withdrawn from school upon reaching their **tenth** consecutive day of unexcused absences.

Tardies

All students are expected to be on time for classes and prepared with necessary materials.

The front gate closes at 7:25am. At that time students will have to enter through the front office. Any student arriving after 7:30am will be considered tardy.

Please note: 5 tardies = 1 absence

Zero-Tolerance

Every student and staff member deserves to be educated in a positive, safe, caring, and respectful learning environment.

Laveen School District holds a zerotolerance policy when dealing with drugs, firearms, bullying, harassment, intimidation, and or fighting. Students can expect suspension and/or expulsion pending investigation.

Sign Out

Campuses of all schools in the Laveen School District are considered to be closed campuses requiring all students to be checked out through the office by a person on the child's contact list. All guardians must also present proper ID.

Early release requests within the last 30 minutes of the school day may be denied

Dress Code

All students are expected to come to school in compliance with the district approved dress code. Students not dressed in accordance with the dress code will be permitted to call home in order to request a parent to bring appropriate clothing. Students out of dress code will not be not be permitted in class until they are in compliance.

Cell Phones

To keep the focus on academics and to reduce unnecessary distractions, personal mobile phones and/or devices must remain off or silent AND completely out of view during the entire school day, this includes hallways and lunch.

Use of phones or electronic devices during the school day may result in confiscation until a parent/guardian can pick it up from the office.

Communication

Cheatham values communication, collaboration, and family engagement. We utilize school apps that support these values and protect class instruction time. When reaching out, please allow up to 24hrs for school staff to respond.


